



POLICIES AND PROCEDURE

Food Safety

In addition to the heavily government regulated food safety rules that we already adhere to, we will:

- Require all suppliers adhere to provincial health and safety requirements when entering the building, this includes but is not limited to donning a mask.
- Immediate sanitization of guest dishware using a liquid submerge system to avoid aerosolization of pathogens.

Cleaning and Sanitation

To protect our staff and guests against pathogen spread, and in addition to our diligent cleaning schedule, we will pay special attention to key touch points such as:

- Interac machines- Door handles - Hand rails, Bathrooms (handles, taps, toilets)
- Chairs - Tablets - Switches - Taps

We will also:

- Only set your table once you have arrived, and not touch your glassware to refill (ie. water, wine, or coffee)

Health & Personal Hygiene

What we ask of you:

- Please do not visit us if you are displaying any Covid-19 symptoms, we reserve the right to refuse entry upon arrival should we feel that you are exhibiting any symptoms.
- Please use hand sanitizer upon entry.
- Please refrain from using cash at this time, we accept all major credit cards, interac, and gift cards.
- Masks are required while moving throughout the building, and can be removed once seated.

What you can expect from us:

- Staff will not be permitted on site if they are displaying any Covid-19 symptoms.
- Frequent handwashing and/or sanitization.
- Our front and back of house staff will don non-medical masks during operating hours.

Social Distancing

- Our tables will be positioned at least 6 feet from all passageways, and other tables.
- We cannot accept any groups over 10, and these guests must be in a family bubble in accordance with Public Health Authority restrictions.
- Bar seating will not be available at this time.
- Dinner by reservation only at this time, please arrive at your reserved seating time only.
- Please observe social distancing while in the building, and do not visit other tables.
